Key Learning

- In Autumn leaves begin to change colour and fall from the trees. Leaves feel crunchy on the ground.
- The weather can often be windy and it can be rainy. It starts to get colder in Autumn.
- We have to choose warmer clothes in Autumn time.
- Animals like hedgehogs begin to get ready to hibernate in Autumn time.
- Squirrels start to hide acorns ready for Winter.
- Artists use leaves and other natural things they find to create artwork.

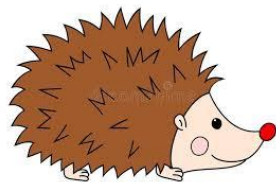

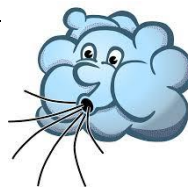
