Key Learning

- There are four seasons, Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter.
- Spring comes after Winter and before Summer.
- The Months March, April and May are in Spring.
- In Spring new life begins to show. Leaves bud and we can see blossom on the trees. New shoots appear from plants and trees.
- We can often see flowers growing from blubs e.g. daffodils.
- The weather can often be sunny and rainy. It starts to get warmer in Spring.
- We can begin to wear less layers in Spring time. We may not need to wear such thick coats.
- Animals that have been hibernating start to come out in Spring as the weather warms up.
- Birds begin to build nests and lots of baby animals are born including chicks and lambs.
- In Spring we celebrate Easter. Easter is a Christian celebration.

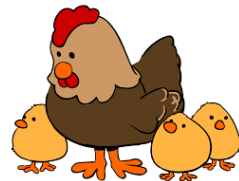
