

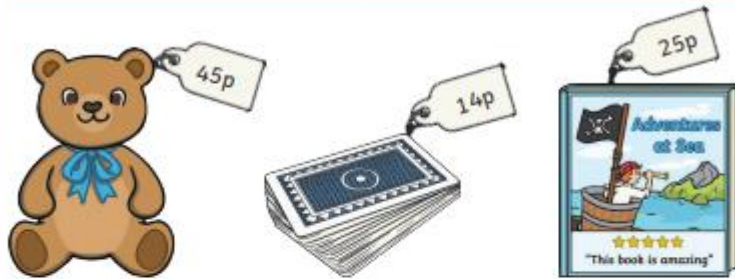

Timek bought two books.

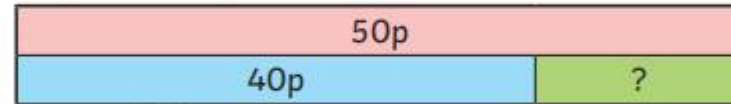


$$25p + 25p = 50p$$

Find the Change

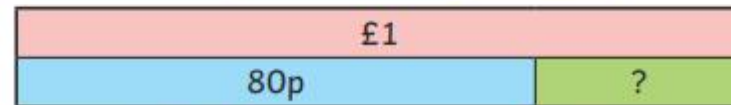
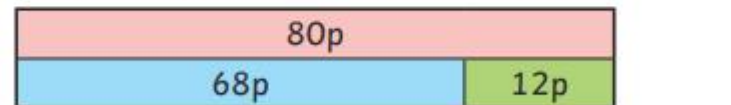


Lucy bought a jigsaw with a 50p coin. How much change did she get?
